



WEISER MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETIC and EXTRA CURRICULAR CODE

Many people closely observe the conduct of a Weiser Middle School athlete. An athlete is a representative of the team, the school and the community. It is important, therefore, that a Weiser Middle School athlete maintains high standards in all aspects of life. Weiser Middle School athletes are expected to follow all training rules as outlined by their coaches, at all times.

1. It is understood that any serious violation of school standards may result in an athlete being suspended from athletic competition for a period of time determined by the principal. Any student receiving an in school or out of school suspension will result in that student missing the next competition.
2. It is understood that before athletes are allowed to practice with the team, they will have their physical exam and proper insurance coverage turned into the main office, will have met the academic requirement, and will have a student body card.
3. It is understood that the athlete accepts the responsibility for all athletic equipment issued and shall provide for its proper care, storage and return. Athletes shall assume responsibility for athletic equipment not returned when due and shall not participate in any other sport until all equipment is either returned, paid for or other arrangements have been made through the coach for replacement.
4. It is understood that the athlete must be in school all day of an athletic competition to be eligible to compete that day. Absences for such things as funerals or doctors appointments must be cleared by the administration.
5. An athlete shall notify the coach immediately if he/she cannot make a scheduled practice. The coach must clear any absences.
6. It is understood that the consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages or other illegal drugs of any kind or the use or possession of tobacco in any form constitutes grounds for immediate suspension from the sport in which the athlete is currently participating. If this violation happens a second time the athlete will be suspended from participating in any other sport.
7. At away activities, Weiser Middle School students will be released to their parents only. When possible, parents should notify the office in writing prior to the team leaving for the activity.
8. The coach and/or principal shall resolve any issue not covered by this code.
9. It is understood that each athlete must attend at least ten practices before they will be allowed to compete. The principal will handle eligibility of transfers into the District.

Athletes are expected to maintain passing grades in all classes in order to participate. Grade reports will be generated once a week. Students failing one class are put on a one week probation (from the date of the original report). During this probation week students may continue full participation in athletics / extra curricular activities and will work to change the failing grade back to passing. If they are failing the following week, regardless of the class, the student will then become ineligible, NO practice / competing. Student must acquire an eligibility pass from the teacher, whose class they are failing, in order to return to full participation in sports/extra-curricular activities.

There will be an admission charge for all athletic games. Students with an activity card will be admitted to games free of charge.

I have read and thoroughly understand the rules given regarding the conduct of Weiser Middle School athlete. Any student who violates any of the regulations has the right of due process. Due process consists of the following:

1. Athlete will be informed of charges.
2. Athlete will be given the opportunity to speak in his/her defense.
3. Athlete will be given the opportunity for appeal.
4. Parents may be present and represent the athlete during the appeal.

When the appeal is made the principal for the purpose of hearing the appeal will form an athletic counsel of three voting members. The council will consist of the principal, one coach outside the sport involved and a guidance counselor.

We understand that these rules are important in helping the student become a good athlete and a good citizen with a high sense of moral integrity, competitive spirit and the ability to be honest and forthright in all endeavors. We understand and agree to abide by these rules.
